

MARJORIE WOOLFOLK FRAZER SCHOLARSHIP FUND

RULES AND REQUIREMENTS

A) ELIGIBILITY

1. The candidate must be a resident of Virginia for a period of not less than 6 months, be enrolled in Culpeper, Louisa, Madison, Orange or Spotsylvania High School High School, or have been accepted into an accredited community college, college, or university
2. The candidate must be eligible and must enter a college that is acceptable to the Scholarship Committee. Accredited community colleges, college, or university will be acceptable for consideration by the Committee. Vocational schools are not acceptable for this award.
3. The candidate must enter the approved college or university within one semester of the awarding of the scholarship. Unforeseen injury, illness or acceptable hardships that may prevent his/her entering until the next semester will not be considered grounds for reversal of the scholarship award.
4. The candidate must possess scholastic ability and favorable personal characteristics as evidenced by:
 - i. A scholastic record and grades acceptable to the Marjorie Woolfolk Frazer Scholarship Committee
 - ii. Recommendations by his/her high school guidance counselor, college advisor or pastor as to:
 1. citizenship activities
 2. character
 3. attitudes toward parents, teachers and students

B) FINANCIAL ARRANGEMENTS

1. This scholarship shall be in the amount of \$500.00. Any change to the award amount shall be done so by a recommendation or change brought before the Church membership by the Committee and a majority vote of approval.
2. This scholarship shall be paid directly to the college or university of the recipient's choice. A certificate shall be presented to the recipient and the check shall be made out to both the recipient and the college or university. This will allow the awardee to apply the funds where he/she wishes.
3. In the event the recipient withdraws from the college or university before or during the first entered semester, the scholarship shall be considered void and shall be refunded by the recipient. These funds shall be deposited into the general account or as directed by the membership at the time of refund.

C) PROCEDURES FOR SELECTION OF THE SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENT

1. Notice of availability and regulations governing this scholarship shall be made available to all Culpeper, Louisa, Madison, Orange and Spotsylvania High School seniors and on the church website www.macedoniachristianchurch-va.org.
2. There shall be a Scholarship Committee composed of no less than 3 members.
3. Any student desiring this scholarship shall complete an application and attach a letter in his/her own words as to why he/she would like to receive this scholarship as well as evidence of need. The application and letter shall be directed to the Scholarship Committee.
4. The Scholarship Committee shall require a letter of recommendation from a representative of the high school, college or Church affiliation. This letter may be attached to the student's application and mailed directly to the Scholarship Committee.
5. The Scholarship Committee shall screen the applicants using the written information available, but shall reserve the privilege of interviewing applicants if necessary.
6. All applications and letters of recommendation must be received or postmarked no later than **8 May 2010** in order to qualify as a candidate.
7. The applicant must pursue a course of study leading to an Associate Degree or higher. Preference will be given to applicants pursuing a degree in Education or related course.
8. Applicants affiliated with Macedonia Christian Church will be given first consideration.
